

I. 1-page brief of each survey, tracer study report or minutes of meeting

The B.N.S. program creates monitoring system to survey graduates 6-month and 1-year employment using questionnaire. All participants (100%) earned job in the past four years. More than 95 percent earned job within six months, and the rest earned job within one year. Most of them works in the tertiary hospital both in public and private hospital. The reasons that the graduates did not earned job within six months related to relaxation one period of time before work and some graduates would like to conduct their own business.

Stakeholders' satisfaction survey was conducted under monitoring of the deputy dean of academic and research affairs. There are four steps as follow: 1) data collection design, identify concerning group, information receiving channel, and data collection period; 2) data collection and analysis; 3) conduction of the improvement plan based on stakeholders' need; and finally, 4) re-assessment for further improvement plan.

Employers: The results of the past 3 years (2015-2017) showed that the employers were satisfied with the learning outcomes of graduates with the average scores of 3.99, 3.65, and 3.69, respectively. In the year 2015, the employers' opinions towards the outstanding of the nursing graduates were responsibility, curiosity to learn, public mind, systematic thinking, and problem solving. The suggestions were on the development of analytical thinking skills, application of knowledge to nursing practice, digital media use, and communication with colleagues, leadership and use of foreign languages.

Alumni: The satisfaction was derived from the graduates. The expected number of respondents is more than 70 Percent and the acceptable result average score should more than 3.50 from 5. It was found that the past 3 years (2015-2017), the average score of satisfaction were 4.45, 4.60, and 4.64, respectively.

Students: The satisfaction was derived from the students. The expected number of respondents is more than 70 Percent and the acceptable result average score should more than 3.50 from 5. It was found that the past 3 semesters (2017-2018), the average score of satisfaction were 3.86, 4.11, and 4.24.

Faculty members: The satisfaction was derived from the faculty members. The expected number of respondents is more than 70 Percent and the acceptable result average score should more than 3.50 from 5. It was found that the past 3 semesters (2017-2018), the average score of satisfaction were 4.21, 4.24, and 4.25.
