Course description and detailed information of internship and cooperative education

Course description

Students work as interns in organizations related to gems and jewelry businesses. Skills applied to further enhance work experience is emphasized together with knowledge in gems and jewelry. Awareness on social responsibilities, work ethics and morality are also focused. Students work as intern no less than 300 hours while as cooperative intern no less than 640 hours.

Expected learning outcomes

- 1. Be ethical, punctual, honest, and responsible for assigned jobs
- 2. Have interpersonal skills and able to work as a team
- 3. Apply knowledge and skills in gems and jewelry with a focus on real work experience in workplace in order to build awareness on responsibility.
- 4. Able to communicate in verbal and written forms with others

- 6. Able to perform work in workplace, and analyze systematically in order to develop work appropriately.
